

Performance Driving and Autocross School June 6th & 15th, 2019

The Boeing Employees' Autosports Club (BEAC*) will present a Performance Driving and Autocross School 6/6 and 6/15. Required classroom session will be held the evening of Thursday June 6th and an instructed driving practice will be held Saturday June 15th, all day.

- 6/15 onsite one-on-one driving instructor time and hands-on driving practice at the Shelton Airport (Sanderson Field). Check-in @ 9 am. Finish @ 5:00 pm. Lunch provided on driving practice day

Participation in the school is limited to persons who are eligible to be members of a Boeing Recreation club; Boeing employees, Boeing retirees, vendors, customers, contract, and government personnel assigned full time to The Boeing Company and their spouses and dependents. - *BEAC is an official Boeing Recreation administered club. Annual dues are \$15 (individual), \$20 (family).
- **"Autocross" is a medium-speed, non-wheel-to-wheel form of motorsports competition in which each car is individually timed through a course laid out on a large paved area using plastic traffic cones. It's conceptually similar to slalom skiing competition. Average speeds are in the low 40's (mph), top speeds typically are no more than 60-65.
