



Performance Driving and Autocross School

The Boeing Employees' Autosports Club (BEAC*) will present a performance driving and autocross school in April. Classroom session will be the evening of Thursday April 11th, and instructed driving practice will be Saturday April 13th all day. Fee of \$40 includes classroom training, on-site driving instruction, hands-on driving practice, and a box or catered lunch is provided by BEAC.

Topics covered include:

- Car control fundamentals
- Handling characteristics
- Driving techniques
- Do's and Don'ts
- Competition driving
- Autocross events**

Participation in the school is limited to persons who are eligible to be members of a Boeing Recreation club; Boeing employees, Boeing retirees, vendors, customers, contract, and government personnel assigned full time to The Boeing Company and their spouses and dependents. Pre-registration is required (deadline 4/5), and a brief safety inspection will be performed on the car the student brings on Saturday. Location for the classroom session is room 202 in the Oxbow Recreation center, bldg. 9-150 just off of E. Marginal Way near the Developmental Center. **"Autocross" is a medium-speed, non-wheel-to-wheel form of motorsports competition in which each car is individually timed through a course laid out on a large paved area using plastic traffic cones. It's conceptually similar to slalom skiing competition. Average speeds are in the low 40's (mph), top speeds typically are no more than 60-65.
